HIV REDUCE YOUR RISK

Use New Needles and New Works

HIV trapped in a needle can live for more than

24 hours

and is very easy to transmit through sharing.

IF YOU ARE EXPOSED TO HIV...

Post-exposure prophylaxis, or PEP, is a medication-based HIV prevention tool which lowers the risk of permanent infection after being exposed to HIV. PEP is only effective if it is taken within 72 hours of a high-risk exposure. PEP is taken for 28 days.



You can access PEP through Red Door Services or any ER.

DISPOSE OF USED NEEDLES IMMEDIATELY AND SAFELY

- A biohazard container is best.
- Other puncture-proof plastic containers will work.
- Bring your container of used needles to Hennepin County Public Health Clinic and exchange for new needles and works.



HEP C REDUCE YOUR RISK

Use New Needles and New Works

80% of people who share needles will come in contact with Hep C.



- Spread through sharing needles, cookers, and cottons.
- Treatable virus – but it can cause liver damage if it is left untreated.
- A blood test can detect Hep C so you can receive medical treatment.
